
STRIPED BASS and/or THEIR HYBRIDS The following characteristics may be used in identifying species:




YELLOW BASS

- A No tooth patch on tongue. Small size, 1-2 lbs. maximum.
- **B** Stripes distinct, broken above anal fin.
- C Dorsal fins joined.
- **D** Color silvery yellow.

WHITE BASS

- A Back of tongue has 1 tooth patch.
- Body deep, more than 1/3 length.
- Stripes faint, only 1 extends to tail. Seldom exceeds 3 lbs.
- **D** 2nd spine 2/3 or more the length of 3rd spine.



STRIPED BASS

- A Back of tongue has 2 distinct tooth patches.
- **B** Body slender, less than 1/3 length.
- Stripes distinct, several extend to tail. 20 lbs. common.
- **D** 2nd spine 1/2 the length of 3rd spine.

HYBRID BASS

- A Back of tongue has 2 distinct tooth patches.
- **B** Body deep, more than 1/3 length.
- Stripes distinct, usually broken, several extend to tail. Seldom exceeds 10 lbs.
- 2nd spine 2/3 or more the length of 3rd spine.
